1. January 31 - The \$1000 Charlie Feath Memorial Scholarship is open to any senior who plans to enroll in an approved undergraduate program of teacher education in an accredited institution of higher education in PA and has a parent that is a member of PSEA and works in a school district in Bedford, Cambria or Somerset County. Applicant must demonstrate a high degree of academic proficiency.
