

## Welcome to the 2021-2022 Academic Year!

Saint Francis University is proud to partner with your high school to offer exciting dual enrollment opportunities for you to get an early start on college through our College in High School Program to...

- Accelerate your college degree to graduate in less than 4 years
- Learn time management skills
- Explore different interests
- Improve your college application
- Increase your chance of scholarships based on academic merit
- More scheduling flexibility to allow for other experiences (study abroad, internships, double major)
- Save money!

In the dual enrollment program, you will earn college credit for the course(s) that you are taking at your high school. These credits will be transcribed here at Saint Francis University and automatically count towards any degree/program pursued at SFU. The credits may also be transferred to another college or university. Although many colleges and universities will recognize these transfer credits, it is not guaranteed that they will accept them. Whether or not a college accepts the credits depends on their policy and the major you choose.

The cost for the dual enrollment courses is **\$58 per credit hour**. Payment for tuition will be due at the time of registration. This cost is significantly less than the regular tuition paid by full-time students at most colleges and universities.

Saint Francis University will be adhering to strict enrollment deadlines. The registration deadline for full year courses and first half (Fall) courses is **Monday, September 27<sup>th</sup>**. The deadline for second half (Spring) courses is **Monday, March 7<sup>th</sup>**. ***These are FIRM deadlines, no exceptions will be made.***

To register for the dual enrollment course(s), you will need do the following by the deadline:

**Step 1: Complete the 2021 College in High School Application** at <https://francis.tfaforms.net/217843> with your parent/guardian. On this form, you will be asked to:

- Provide student information (name, address, email, etc...)
- Select the course(s) that you would like to enroll
- Provide parental consent

**Step 2: Submit payment for the tuition cost.** Upon submission of the 2021 College in High School Application, you will be asked to submit payment for the total tuition cost through the PayPal Payment system. You do not need a PayPal account to make this payment, you can submit the payment as a guest. The cost per credit is \$58. You **will not** be registered in the course(s) until the payment is received.

Upon receipt of your completed application/registration, Saint Francis University will process the application and register you for the appropriate course(s). You will receive a confirmation email welcoming you to the College in High School program within **2 business days.**
