Tested Positive	Household Member Positive
Isolate at home for 5 days from start of symptoms.	
 Student/staff may return on day 6 if they are Asymptomatic or symptoms are improving. Fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications. He or she must wear a mask for days 6-10. 	Quarantine is not required if student/staff is asymptomatic and has not tested positive. If symptoms develop, follow <i>Tested Positive</i> column.
If student/staff wishes to not wear a mask for days 6-10, they have the option of either 1. Isolating for the full 10 days or 2. Providing a negative test to return.

Definitions

<u>Symptom Start Date</u> = Day 0 <u>Asymptomatic</u>: no symptoms

<u>Isolation</u>: separates sick individual from non-sick.

Fever-reducing medications: Ibuprofen (Motrin/Advil), Acetaminophen (Tylenol), Naproxen (Aleve).

Many cold medicines have these ingredients.
